

EDUCATIONAL OFFICER P/R/C Bob Rayburn, SN-IN

Boat Handling Class begins on March 29th.

This class does not take you out on the water to learn how to handle your boat, especially when it is still too cold for shorts and tees! What the course does provide is information to help you build understanding about the fundamentals of



boating. Being on the water has a special allure for people. For those that wish to explore the onthe-water environment this course will help you prepare for that adventure.

Six two-hour sessions will provide a knowledge foundation for use on the water. That information will help you recognize and develop skills for more effective boat operations. The Boat Handling content will help you prepare for potential challenges and give you the confidence to use your boat more often and in more places. The course is written by boaters who have experience with problems and solutions encountered on the water as traditional powerboaters and sailors.

A brief look at the course overview will give a picture of the information you will experience during the six sessions. Just as we learned when driving a car there are rules for on-the-water boat operation. You will build a keen awareness of the signs and signals you might see from your boat. Slow speed maneuvering will help you anticipate the actions needed when docking or moving in a marina. Recognizing how to handle your boat under

Looking forward to getting to know you. various conditions will help you make decisions on the practices you wish to follow. Anchoring knowledge and techniques provides options for enjoying the water as well as handling possible emergencies.

Emergencies on board is another section. While many situations are small, preparing for potential problems will allow you to care for the boat as well as the people on it. Having thought about what you may deal with is not fun, but doing it will give you the preparation to make any challenges more workable. In each of the sessions you will be introduced to knots that will allow you to secure your boat at your dock and other locations. The final session will provide practice and application of knots, line handling and answering questions or actions you would like to explore further. During the classes different learning aids and activities will be used to help you start developing the skills and knowledge to feel comfortable on the water.


